Ordered that the Law of the Cook Islands see the  
Act lately made relating thereto be put in Execution.

His Excellency is pleased to say that he will go and  
see the Land laid out & a proper place to build the Fort  
marked out.

Ordered that Mr. Atty Genl take care about the Narr  
gation Bonds that have facias issue to receive the Judgments  
but that the executions be suspended.

Robert Handocks petition and the being matter of Law  
is referred to Mr. Atty Genl

Ordered that when the publick Revenue & the several  
Debt's are stated that warrants be drawn for his Majesty's  
Recievers to pay what is due to his Excellency the Governor  
according to his Majesty's Royal Instructions & the Act  
of Assembly.

Ordered that the Clerk of the provincial Court give  
his Majesty's Atty General a full Acc't of all fines by For  
feitures & Amerciaments who is to take care to have them  
Levied.

Ordered that George Parker & George Muschamp Esqrs  
his Majesty's Receivers return fair Transcripts of all Acc'ts  
to the Right Honourable his Majesty's Auditor General
