It is ordered that Proclamations issue that the Court of Chancery Court of Appeals before his Excellency the Gov^r & Council Court of Admiralty & Commissarys Court will be holden here the 23^d day of February next & that unless it should please God that such violent weather should happen by Frost or Snow or otherwise that the Justices cannot properly attend the said Courts their cases will not be continued

It is also ordered that the County Levy this year ordered that the several Justices within this Province take care to apprise their parishioners the 10th of Feb^r if not as by Law they are Impowered in regard the Burthen thereof will be less this year than another & that the Vestrymen where they see it absolutely necessary that they will lend the same to the Commissioners of the County Courts for the support of the poor of their respective parishes to be repaid them out of the next years County Levy & that the Justices apprise their parishioners as soon as may be the better to enable the several Sheriffs to collect the same

Ordered that Copies of the publick Levy be sent to each County Court there to be read & affixed up at the Court House soon that all persons may see how
