Nine pence Sterl by the said George Muschamp recd of the  
fourth part of the 12<sup>f</sup> tht given by his most Sacred Maj<sup>y</sup>  
for the Supplying this Province with Arms & Ammunition  
to which the said George Plater was directed to apply w<sup>t</sup>  
the purchasing thereof but soasmuch as the said George  
Plater hath not fully Compted with the direction given  
him therein evident therefore that the said Geo Muschamp  
pay unto his Excellency Sir Nicholson Esq<sup>r</sup> Capt Gen<sup>r</sup> of  
the mil<sup>t</sup> in Chief in & over this his Maj<sup>y</sup> Province &c Sixty  
two pounds five Shillings Sterl being the Ballance of the  
last this day given of the said qu<sup>r</sup> part of the 12<sup>f</sup> tht  
w<sup>t</sup> by his Majesty allotted as aforesaid
