

Bills of his said to enter for the duty of tobacco  
bound the same day in this Province before the  
22<sup>d</sup> day of December last being the day on which  
the Excellency Sir Robert Johnson his Majesty's late  
Captain General & Governor in chief of this Province  
& now Governor of Virginia by virtue of his Majesty's  
royal commission entered upon the Government  
of this Colony

Whereupon ordered that the Receiver & Na-  
tural Officers do take the said Bills payable unto his  
Excellency Sir Robert Johnson his Majesty's Captain  
General & Governor in chief of this Province & that  
they the said Receiver & Natural Officers as also the  
Collectors take an exact account from the several Masters  
of Ships upon their clearing of what Tobaccoes they  
had on Board before the said 22<sup>d</sup> day of December  
last

The Attorney General's motion to his Excellency  
to settle the bills of the Court of Admiralty is refer-  
red to the next meeting of the Board
