

. That it is laid before the next Assembly to consider the next
Plan which will shew the place in case Doctor Bayly do not
come in may be supplied with some able Doctor.

. His Excellency proposes to the Board that whereas
there are several judgments upon Navigation Bonds
whether it be not fit that Examiners should give them over.

. The Board do advise his Excellency that the execution
of the said judgments be suspended for that they are of
Opinion that if any person should be executed therefore
they have not wherewithal to make satisfaction and
it would affright many persons out of the Country.

. The Act of Assembly made in September 1694 encl
