Produced & read a Letter from Mr. Thos. Lane
& Mr. Rundall Bewing explaining of one John Parker
who had intruded upon & built a house within the
Bounds of the Land laid out for the Indians in Somersett
County of which the said Indians complain & the said
Gentlemen further acquaint his Excellency that they fear
some disturbance may be occasioned thereby.

His Excellency with the advice of the Board doth
thereupon order that Mr. John Rundall one of his Majt
Justices of the Provincial Court residing in Somersett
County do inquire wherein & remove the said Parker
forthwith entry according to Law & for the better satisfaction
of the said Indians.

Read the petition of Mr. John Conner the Factor
of Mr. John Rogers of Plymouth purposing their signm't
of Mayor William Whitington & Mr. John Wells the
officer Bond for Somersett County against whom the said
Mr. John Rogers has a claim against them for £665.
