Gentlemen further acquaint his Excellency that they fear
some disturbance may be occasioned thereby

His Excellency with the advice of the Board does
thereupon order that Mr John Rowland one of his Maj
Justices of the Provincial Court residing in Somerset
County do inquire therein & remove the said Parker
for his entry according to Law & for the better satisfacti-
ons of the said Indians

Read the petition of Mr John Conice the Factor
of Mr John Rogers of Plymouth praying the discharge
of Mayor William Whitingtons & Mr John West the
Suff Bond for Somerset County against whom the said
Mr John Rogers has a claim against the one for 400
Tob & the other 1738/6 10/0

the said Sheriff's Bonds be assigned & a Special
