Whereas Mr John Liret of Ulster County  
had been indicted there two days past charging him to have  
rendered himself to Justice but had delayed his to do so  
Hath he by given notice to the Sheriff of Ulster  
County for his appearance Examining what was  
Obliging against him in the Provincial Court on his  
Majestys Behalf

Ordered that the Sheriff of Ulster County  
take the said Mr John Liret into his custody & bring  
him before the Justice of His Majestys Provincial  
Court to be dealt with according to Law.

It being represented at the Board that Sir Col<sup>t</sup> John Liret had refused to act as a Justice of  
the Provincial Court he is not thought worthy of  
being chief Justice of Ulster County or serving in  
any other Commission in this Government.

Ordered that Maj Walker Smith be appointed  
chief Judge of Ulster County Court.
