 Coll<sup>d</sup> Uddeborn to be distributed among the poor Inha-  
 bitants in the frontiers

The Council desire his Excellency will be pleased  
 that in case any further Mischief happens to be done  
 by Indians that he will be pleased to take such speedy  
 care thereupon as in his discretion he shall think  
 fit

His Excellency is pleased to acquaint the Board

 before he had received from Coll<sup>d</sup> Quay he suspected to
