

General Assembly of his Majesty's Province
of Maryland do command the 1st day of Nov^r
in the fifth year of his Majesty's Reign as also to all
that shall be after Capable to make Good in chief of the
said Province dated the 19th day of October in the tenth
year of his Majesty's Reign the Governor Council by
order of the said Province having impowered to make
such Laws as they shall see fit to be in force until his Majesty
shall have given his assent to the same or
otherwise be signified to the contrary & given such as in
the course of the said Province the said Laws have past
in the General Assembly of the said Province in the year
1690 & 1699 the first intended laws for the establish-
ment of the Protestant Religion within the Province
which were relative concerning all the Laws of England
to be in force in Maryland which cause it of another
name than what was set forth by the Title of the said
Law the other Law being an act concerning the Laws
of this Province which laws having been passed
by the said Legislature of late & remitted by
the said House of Commons to the Board for his Majesty's
consideration concerning the said Laws.
