

Treaty & League Permutations

It being the Board's intention to give three Opinions that permutants as matters they are expected to arrive here next October next by which such Letters might be expected Captain Hurd who is now absent on being the last the meeting of the Assembly should be no further deferred but that it is ^{of the} absolutely necessary they should sit upon the 26th first according to Provisions.

His Excellency represents to the Board that the last year (1799) finding that Colonel Mitchell for his Services rendered for some time received the 3^d part given by his Majesty to the Country for purchase of Land &c he also had received the said 3^d part that year but that he was content since he understood his Majesty's Receivers Geo. Hales & Geo. Muschamp Esq^r were the same appointed & Commissioned he would no longer sit in middle thereof.

His Excellency informs them that he had advanced & lent the Country two hundred pounds there which he had sent to Col^l Addison to pay & subject the Prisons on the falls of Potomack who when in great want thereof and could not have had that money without the meeting of the Committee which would have been a great Charge to the Country.

His Excellency further gives them to understand that he is informed by M^r Henrage Robinson an Indian Trader that the Emperor of Russia's Army & his Indians will come to Town on Monday
