the Indians be told to come in & live upon their lands

they carry some of the English along with them to Rock
Creek to see their fort demolished there.

Mr John Dansey Surveyor presented a Commiss
ion from the honble his Majestys Commiss of the Customs
to be Collector of Pownack & Steward appointed by
Act of Parliament instead of the Office of Collector
& Supremacy Administred to him as likewise the said
appointed by the act of the 1st & 8th Years of his present
Majestys Reign entituled an act for preventing frauds
& Regulating abuses in the plantation trade which
he took & likewise subscribed the Test & Association h[er]e
Given Bond in England for the faithful Execution of his
Office

There was produced & read a Commission from
the honble the Commiss of the customs to W^m Bladen
the Surveyor of the port of Annapolis whereby in the
afforessd Oaths were administered which he took &
also Subscribed the Test & Association & entered into
Bond with the honble Thomas French Esq & Major
William Bent his security for the faithful Execution
of his said Office
