Building his house he is directed to apply to the Assembly
by sending some of his men when the General As
sembly sits

The Indians complain that the English kill
their Traps in Pears and hinder their hunting his
Excellency says he will take care for the future to pre
vent that

They are told of their Breach of Articles and asked
if they are desirous for to enter into new ones to which
they say they are

And it being concluded & agreed upon that the King
should with his wife & Children within two months
come in of Siveat Stamunkey & do his utmost endeavor
ours to persuade the rest of the Indians to do so
likewise

Ordered that Articles of peace be prepared with
the Agreement last mentioned inserted & in all other
Points as they were before

Ordered also that Articles of peace be prepared
for the Stamunkey Indians
