

And then his Excellency was pleased to give every
one of the said Indians presents of of greater value to
Col^o James for his Majesty the King of Samanichey
& to the Emperor & Indiaron King's Wives & others of
greater Note

And then told them to come again to morrow
morning to sign the said Articles of peace

Tuesday April 9th 1700

His Excellency the Governor & the Indians again
well & were present as before

The following Articles being prepared & read were
consentingly agreed to & signed by the Subscribers as
followeth viz

Articles of Peace & Amity concluded
& agreed upon between his Ex^{ty} Nathaniel
Blakiston Esq^r Captain General & Governor
in Chief in & over this his Majesty's Province of
Maryland & the Territory therunto belonging
& Quahmiquah Empire of Pennsylvania
the 8th day of April 1700.

Imprimis It is agreed upon that from this day
forward there shall be inviolable peace & amity between
his most Excellent Majesty King William the third of
England &c & his Subjects the Inhabitants of this
Province & the Empire of Pennsylvania upon the
Article hereunto mentioned to the w^{ch}ts end to remove
& that all former Acts of Hostility & Damages
whatsoever by either party sustained be believed in
forgotten & oblivion
