quiet & peaceable enjoyment & use of their Religion wout
the least molestation whatsoever therefore we greatly
wrong that Law & the Govt by their Instruction in the
first section & third exception

We humbly assure your Lordships that what
ever titles founders may give themselves of dissenting
Protestants there has no sect of Religion here opposed
that Law but the Papists & Quakers who from the
first Beginning of his Majestys happy Govt here
with which that Law entred have with their greatest
Might obstructed it & so diligent were they therein
