

Read the Receipt of the Countess's said Letter
wherein they certify the Law that Captain Henry
Munday Master of the Ship John Howland of Lond
a Dealer into this Province being upon the coast of
Virginia in November last was but by a Pirate who
robbed & plundered him; that some of the said
Captain Munday's men run from him to the Py
rate who was named Henry King & formerly used
the Pennsylvania Trade

Ordered that Information if any was taken
& taken the said Pirate Henry King & Captain
Munday's men in case they happen to come into
these Parts

Produced & read his Majesty's order in council
of the 23rd of November 1699 Relating to Com
missions made of Commanders of Ships of War
preparing & carrying away indentured Servants and
Peoples

Whereupon his Excellency says that he has
given strict orders to Captain Peter Coote Commander
of his Majesty's Ulster Boat Mess. attending this
Province to have due regard thereto and has likewise
Ordered him a copy thereof

Read the Proceedings of his Excellency the
Governor & Council of Virginia of the 23rd of May
1700

Whereupon Captain Coote's orders from the Lords
of the Admiralty as well in relation to his attending
as well here as Virginia were produced & read

And the Board being informed that the said
