upon the 11th day of January published until the 28th
of October instant before which no emergency affairs
nor supplies whereby to occasion the meeting thereof
at that time I have thought fit to do by & make the ad-
vised Commiss^{ion} of his Majesty's humble Council of this
Province hereby farther to charge the said General Assembly
till the 9th day of February next ensuing to do
as is published & given to the several Members of his
Majestys Council as also of the house of Pele-
gated that if it shall be thought advisable for his Maj-
esty & the people of this Province that the Gen^t^l
Assembly should be convened & sit on the said 9th day
of February they shall have notice given them by the
several & respective Sheriffs of this Province who
are hereby commanded to publish this my Proclama-
tion given under my hand & the Great Seal of this
Province the 1st day of October in the 11th year of his
Majestys Reign the anno Domini 1699.
