& the Indian names both Indian & English which
are to be recorded that we may know who are our
friends & who not

Whereas I have Granted to the Emperor of his
cunning and the Indians under his command that
shall by their ready compliance & coming in accept

of Peace & Amity with his Majesty's good Subjects of
this Province in compliance whereunto the said Empe-
ror is come in & given an account that he believes
and others of these Indians are willing & desirous
to do the same and that his the said Emperors wife
