Ordered that the Articles of peace with the Emp^r
of Maricar & the other adjacent Indians be confir.
med & confirmed as we have reason to suspect some
hunting from some Indians that hunt here & the
other Nations that the said Indians call home their
Indians on this side the Bay least any Injury should
be done them upon any Violence or Injury offered by
other Indians unknown

bly for paying the publick & County Services in Money
& not in Labor his excellency is pleased to ask the
Advises of the Board if they think it would occasion
