come over the way which is extreme hazardous by
reason of the great storms which do and may happen.

W^r Thomas Fisher & that the late Sir Thomas

cient number thereof even upon the most urgent
occasions for his Majestys service he therefore required
this Board to join with him in nominating three
presenting to his Majestys such & so many Gentlemen
Inhabitants of this Province who were best affected
to his Majestys Interest of good Estates & capable
of serving him within this Province to supply their
Places at this Board whereupon the Gentleman of
the Council present on due consideration & mature
Deliberation had do nominate & recommend to his
Excellency to be present W^r Thomas Lawrence his
