

Pursued and sent his Majestys three Letters to  
the Secretary of the 2d of May 1702.

Appointing Coll Edward Lloyd M<sup>r</sup> James  
Lander & Coll William Scotland to be of his  
Majestys Council of the Province

Whereupon the said three Gentlemen appearing  
at the Board were accordingly sworn and admitted  
of his Majestys Council within this Province the  
very first when the Oaths appointed by act of Par  
instead of the Oaths of Allegiance & Supremacy  
& Subscribed the Test & Affection of their worthiness  
Places at the Board

Pursued and sent his Majestys Letter.....  
of the 19<sup>th</sup> of January 1702 directing a supply of  
650 £ Sterling to be furnished by this Province for the  
Act & Defence of the Frontiers of his Majestys Province  
of New York

Which being taken into due consideration by  
this Board desiring to secure a dutiful Compliance  
to his Majestys Commands.

It is their opinion that in regard the Gov<sup>t</sup> of  
New York has never yet called for the said sum it  
would have been very chargeable to this Province to  
have convened the Assembly on purpose only to have  
supplied the said sum neither would it have been  
advisable upon the first Receipt therof to have then  
Imposed it to the Assembly here who might perhaps  
have followed the example of our adjacent Neighbors  
in refusing the said sum but that it being convenient
