 Very Remote from the Seat of Government had signified
 to them his inclination of leaving his practice & desire
 of being discharged from that Service & therefore desired this
 Board to represent whom they thought fittest to be appoin-
 ted to serve his Majesty in that Employment who are
 pleased to say they do think William Bladen very fit for
 that Service
