

I audience Bawme the Master-scribler of the Clerk of  
the General Assembly of the Province of New-Bark, who is to enter  
the names of all persons appointed by Commissioned to  
any Office in this Province by the same when or where it may  
be publicly known who are the Officers civil & military  
within this Province

Ordered that the Sheriff of the several Countyes make  
a monthly Return of all such Officers names & the  
dates of their Commissions

It being proposed that whereas the Government of  
this her Majestys Province by his Excellency's Direction  
devolved upon the President & Council how the several  
Commissions to be issued under the Great Seal should bear  
etc.

Resolved that they bear this Seal Whence Our  
Truly and well Beloved Thomas Tench Esq<sup>r</sup> President  
of Our Council within this our said Province

Then runs the Great Seal likewise unto his Honour  
the President as also the several Commissions of Comts of  
Suffolk & Foreign Plantations & City of Boston & others &  
those from the Commissrs of the Customs Comts of the Admira-  
lity &c according to order of the last Council

His Honour the President desires the advice of  
the Board where it may be proper to Lodge them who say  
they think the Council Office the properest place

Resolved that this Board will write to his Excellency  
the Lord Cornbury and Colonel Nicholson her Majesties  
Governor of New York and Virginia to acquaint them of  
his Excellency Col<sup>r</sup> Blakistons departure and the Govt  
being devolved upon the President of Council & to desire  
their Friendship to this Province
