

Of September acquainting his Honour that I was of the
Subaltern on the River had informed said County Court
that there were some to know some Indians that have
brought valuable Apparel belonging to men & women (as
said) but neither more

His Honour acquaints the Board that supposing
some Robberys might have been committed in this Province
he had discovered M^r Thomas Booth of Prince Georges
County thereabout & made great inquiry but could not hear
of any Robbery there whereupon he had wrote to Colonel
Nicholson his Majesty's Governor of Virginia giving him an
Account thereof & shewance any such Robbery had been com-
mitted in that Government

This matter being thought worthy of further Inquiry
Ordered that M^r John Hall and M^r Matthew Sanders be
sent as Commissioners and John Ham. Tillman as
Interpreter go to the said Indians at Conestoga inquire
into this Report and if they find any such Goods that they secure them & enquire
what Indians brought them by under their Government
that they see them forth coming
