 may be translated from the said Parish to Christ Church
 Parish in Calvert County some vacant which is unanim-
 mously desired by all the Vestry & Parishes now does ap-
 pear by their address to his Honour the humble President
 of the Society which great act of Charity to him and his distressed
 Family he shall ever acknowledge.

 not understanding then the Affairs of this Country
