of such what great act of Charitie to him and his deffected  
Family he shall ever acknowledge.

Represents that his mission into these parts by my Lord  
Bishop of London is not confined to any place in Parochial  
but in general to performe the ministeriall function  
in the Province of Maryland and his being chosen to be  
sent to Maryland made his request your Honours most

thinking there was some advantage to be settel on a Globe  
not understanding then the Affairs of this Country
