Direct a day for a solemn thanksgiving to be observed
in this Province

Ordered that Proclamation issue appointing the
first of May for the said Solemnity at the Town &
Seat of Annapolis in Annapolis County & the
29th of the same month in all other parts of this
Province

The President acquaints the Board that he had
Upon Oath received a Complaint of some unwarrantable
Actions committed by Captain Nathaniel Bostock
Commander of her Majesty's Advice Boat Eagle within
the Government and thereupon produced the Honble.
James Sanders Esq^r & Captain James Mitchell's De-
positions concerning the Violence used by Captain Bos-
tack upon the Supperday on Board the Quier's Advice
Boat which are as follow
