with the enclosed Papers being Propositions Council
proceeding and last Friday Orders for your Government

Your Excellency may be pleased to perceive how kind
that her Majestys Government has been in assisting &
Supplying him for her Majestys service also how kindly
we have treated him in giving him due notice of some
detention & in giving him advice what in Reference of
the Government when upon his refusal to comply with
the orders the State of Maryland no longer to forbear
