Maryland — Calvert County March the 9th 1703

By virtue of his late Majestys Commission directed to the Excellency Mstr Blakeney Esq^r Rector of Maryland & with Authority to the Commander in Chief of his Majestys honble Council Commanding him upon just cause to command the said Captain Boscawen to present himself to the Commander of his Majestys Navy within this Province & to commit him into Custody either on Board some ship or vessel where according to their Discretion it shall appear that Captain Mstr Boscawen Commander of her Majestys Ship Eagle Board has committed some Treason of Cittie against him by this Government & by Complaining & representing to them that he has contrived & concerted ^{righted} his Majestys Government contrary to his Instructions wherupon with the Advice of the Council and Authority of the said Majestys Council I do hereby command the said Capt Mstr Boscawen from his Commission Board the said Ship Eagle & strictly Charge him in his Majestys Name command you to take unto your Command the late named Capt Mstr Boscawen & have safe keeping before of his Majestys Majl^t advice here will you stand him within the mouth of James River until you shall have written the mouth of James
