Matters viz

Maryland - Capt. Bostock March the 9th 1733

By virtue of his late Majesty's Commission directed to the Excellency Math. Blakiston Esq^r Gov^r of Maryland & in his absence to the Commander in Chief & President of his Majesty's honble Council in suspending him upon just cause known to suspend any Commander of his Majesty's Navy within this Province & to commit him into custody either on Board his own ship or else where according to their Discretion so it is that Captain Math Bostock Commander of her Majesty's Eagle Ulster Boat has committed some Breach of Obedience granted him by this Government & by Complaint & information committed ^{sighted} & continued ~~her Majesty's Government contrary to his Instructions~~ ^{with the Advice of} the Council and Authority of this her Majesty's Council I do hereby suspend the said Capt Math Bostock from his Command on Board the said Ship Eagle & strictly Charge & in her Majesty's Name command you to take into your Custody the aforesaid Capt Math Bostock & him safe keep on Board of her Majesty's Eagle Ulster Boat until you shall receive further the words of James
