That was Received & read his Excellency the Gov^r
 of Virginia's Letter to the honorable President of the 23 of May
 wherein his Excellency acknowledges the receipt of two of his
 Honours Letters of the 22 of February & 6 instant but
 not of that sent by the Eagle Advice Boat which is supposed
 not to be delivered to his said Ex^{ty} also his said Excellency
 was pleased to communicate to this Gov^r that he had embargued
 the Ships in his Government until the 13 of May further his
 said Excellency was pleased to send a Copy of the Orders he
 had given to Capt Boflock to return to this Government to
 carene his Ship here & then desired the President & Council
 so soon as the Ship here could be got ready to Join the Ships
 there bound for England the said Captain Boflock with her
 Majesty's Advice Boat Eagle might be sent down to Virginia
 for her Majesty's Service in that Colony
