Gent I send you immediate answer

The said Peter Hougham being advised of he had brought  
any answer from Captain Bowstock to this Board says there  
he has nothing further to deliver than he has nothing to  
do with the Command of the Ship nor has been addressed  
with by Captain Bowstock as the Boatman & payed  
him by the said Captain

Came the Marshall & upon his acquainting the  
Board that upon his going to the Englishmen Board  
when he was within a small distance of the Ship Capt  
Bowstock asked their Board

Hougham he told him his Business was with the  
Commissaries duty of that said Captain Bowstocks  
and I am he & then sent the Commissioners the Ship side  
to take what Prison he had who took them & on his sight  
gave them w Captain Bowstock & Hougham he requiring  
an Answer one of the men whom said Marshall sent  
to him to ask for another said he should have one by  
13<sup>th</sup> whereupon he went to his Boat about half an  
Hour by the Ship side not being sufficient room on Board  
& this Capt Bowstock sent his Boats to tell him the Orders  
regarding the same
