Came Panguas an Eastern Shore Indian at Mani-
 cote & Commander there & Complaind that his Cabin
 had been broken open by a certain Negro belonging either
 to Major Thomas Taylor of Dorchester County or Mr.
 Peter Taylor his son from whence the said Negro had
 stolen divers goods of a considerable value which the said
 Panguas mentioned part whereof were found upon him
 & were restored the other having been made away by the
 said Negro for which he demands sixty nine Pieces of
 Silver but his Complaint being Considered and he being
 Offered Sixty Pieces of Silver says if they be good ones he will
 be Satisfied

Ordered therefore that Mr. Peter Taylor or Mr. Tho-
 Taylor pay the said Sixty drest Pieces of Silver to the said
 Panguas before Col. Thomas Ennals who is to be Judge
 of the worth of the said Goods & is hereby Ordered to punish
 the Negro by whipping otherwise in case of Refusal he
 is to Commit the negroe to Goal to be prosecuted in the Pro-
 Court for that Offence
