sprawling thereupon he had corrected him

since which the said Gerrard had absented him-  
self viz. from the 19<sup>th</sup> Instant and as he is  
informed applyed himself to the Hon<sup>ble</sup>  
Genelm Cheseldyn Esq<sup>r</sup> one of Her Majestys  
Council before whom he had sworn the  
Peace against him and thereupon the said Mr<sup>r</sup>  
Cheseldyn had issued his warrant to apprehend  
the said Dansey and his wife -

This Board do say that it is not usuall to  
suffer Servants to Swear the peace against  
their Masters that if it should it might be  
very inconvenient -

Ordered that Mr<sup>r</sup> Cheseldyn be wrote to,  
not to countenance the said Gerrard.
