Government, and to give us an Account
thereof.

Further Resolved that this affair be
said before the next Session of Assembly in
Such manner as shall be directed by this Board
at their next meeting.

the Said Letter. Mr. Joseph Holt's Petition
Read. And Ordered that Edward Hilliard
the Church Warden be summoned to appear
