

Ordered that the Said Humphrey Hannaman be  
remanded.

And the Question being referred to her  
Majesty's attorney General whether Humphrey  
Hannaman being committed for assisting Don Juan  
Celia, the Indian and a felon to break the Prison  
on Sunday the 25<sup>th</sup> of March last & against whom  
there is violent presumption of Rescuing the Said  
Prisoners (committed for Treason and Burglary) is not  
by Law liable to the same pains and Judgment  
as if those Prisoners had been actually convicted.

The Said attorney General says he will be in  
the same Circumstances if the Evidences amount  
to a Conviction but what he can find it is only  
Presumptive and so being committed on Suspicion  
thinks he may be admitted to Bail.
