Two pieces of Silver Plate The one Cut or engraved
with the Arms of England & his late Majesty the
other with a Cypher W. M. Mary Rex: Regina here:
before used as the Great Seal of this Province which
I do promise upon my safe arrivall in England
(God willing) to Deliver to Sir Nathaniel Blakiston
Agent for the Province of Maryland in order to Carry to
their Lordships the Lords of Trade & Plantations
to take Cold Blakistons Receipt therefore.
