AMK

That we are sensible that if actual Tax ought to
 be taken to oblige the Members of our Council
 to a due Attendance therein, in order to pre-
 vent the many Inconveniences that may
 happen from the want of a Quorum of
 Council to transact Business, or occasion
 may require, It is our Will & pleasure
 that if any of the Members of our
 Council shall hereafter willfully absent
 themselves when duly summoned without
 a just and lawful Cause and shall persist
 therein after admonition you suspend
 the said Counsellors in absentsing themselves
 till our further pleasure be knowne
 giving by timely Notice thereof -
 And We do hereby Will and require you that
 this our Royall Commandment be manifested
