Advised that wheresoever many persons in this Province
are disaffected to the Government & protestant
Succession as established by Law, to the end
may be knowne what number of papists &
reputed papists are residing in this Province
Orders sh^{al}l be given to the severall Sheriffs of y^e respective
Countys to take a List of the said papist Names
as well Masters of Families as Inmates Servants
& Negroes baptiz'd in that Religion and return
the same to his Majesty the Governour of
this Province at such time as shall be
