

His Majesty's Letters under the Great Seal of Great Britain
 bearing date and plantation, Letter of
 the 7th of May 1707 signifying that an Act of
 Parliament had past in England uniting
 Her Majesty's two Kingdoms of England, Scotland
 into One by the Name of Great Britain - and
 that two printed Copies of y^e said Act were sent
 to her Majesty's Highness was pleased to say the said
 Copies never came to his hands or any directed
 in this matter before their Lordships Treasurers
 which was brought from the fourteenth of
 June last upon Receipt whereof he had
 made the most solemn preparation for
 proclaiming her Majesty Queen of Great
 Brittain, and having issued a Proclamation
 to the severall Countys therefore desired the
 Advice of the Board if the High Sheriffs
 of the County were not y^e fittest
 person on horseback and whilst his Highness
 y^e Reviewing y^e severall Troops of the
 Militia now in Town to proclaim her
 most Sacred Majesty Anne by the Grace of
 God Queen of Great Brittain France
 & Ireland & the Dominions thereto
 belonging defend y^e Faith & Liberty
 and reading the Act of Union which
 was approved of by the Board and Her
 Majesty's Board and Her
