 said Indians came and acquainted by the  
 they were disturbed in their Lands and that  
 John Kellum was scot in their Land, John  
 Parker fallen wounded trees and clear their  
 Ground - George & Thomas John Beveny & others  
 Lands are scabed within their Grounds -

Ordered that Col. William W. Hittington should  
 the said Indian Lands and make Report to  
 his Highness with all convenient Speede what  
 persons and whether any have encroached  
 and scabed within the said Indian Lands  
 that care may be taken to redress Aggravations  
 and in case they have forably entered and  
 beyond the Indian Lands they be prosecuted  
 for the trespass in order to deter others -  
 and that the said Colonel W. Hittington call  
 what Warrants are necessary to discover  
 the Bounds of the said Indian Lands -

Resolved that the Council meete the  
 sixteenth day of August next and that  
 Letters be wrote to the severall Members  
 to give their attendances accordingly.
