Four of her Majesty's Royall Letters dated at
Kensington the 23^d of Feby 1708 in the sixth
year of her Majesty's Reign under her Sign Manual
& countersigned by the Right Hon^{ble} the Duke of
Sunderland her Majesty's principall Secy of State
and sealed with her Majesty's Lesser Seale appointing
Col: John Contee Lieut. Biggs Esq: Samuel Young
Esq: & Colonel Thomas Greenfield to be of her
Majesty's Council in this Province were
read at the Board and ordered to be Entred
in the Journall of this Days proceedings -
Colonel John Contee and Mr. Lieut. Biggs being
both dead since the said Letters came to hand
and Mr. Samuel Young having been already
sworne of the Council for want of a competent
Number - The hon^{ble} Colonel Tho. Greenfield
was sworne one of the Members of this Board &
having taken the Oath of Allegiance & Subscription
to signed the List together with the rest according
to the order thereto at the Board -
