Then it was proposed whether it may
not be proper to erect this Town and Port
of Annapolis into a City with the Privilege
of sending two Citizens to y^e Gen^l Assembly
and some other small priviledges such as
shall be agreed on by his Excellency & this Board
To which the Board do say that it will
be very proper this being the Seat of
Government & a growing place & having
the most Buildings & people inhabiting
therein - The Council then broke up.
