

of Wales Town of Berwick upon Tweed Isles of  
Jersey Guernsey Alderney Sark or any of Her  
Majesties Plantations should become void by  
Reason of the Demise of Her late Majesty  
Her Heirs or Successors Kings or Queens of the  
Realm; but that every person or persons in  
any of the Places Offices and Employments aforesaid  
should continue in their respective Offices Place  
and Employments aforesaid for the space of six Months  
next after such Death or Demise unless sooner  
renewed and discharged by the next Successor  
to whom the Imperial Crown of this Realm  
was limited and appointed to go remain and  
descend; and that all Officers <sup>in any Office Place or Employment</sup> who should be  
that yet continued should take the Oath there  
mentioned, and do all other Acts requisite by  
Law of this Realm to qualify themselves to  
be and continue in such their respective  
Offices and Employments within such Time  
and in such manner and under such pains  
penalties and Disabilities as they should ought  
to do had they been newly elected, appointed or  
stituted and put into such Offices Places or Em-  
ployments in usual and ordinary way - And  
therefore with the advice of His Majesties most  
honorable Privy Council do hereby direct and com-  
mand all persons who at the time of the Demise  
of Her late Majesty were duly and lawfully pro-  
fessed or invested in any Place or Employment  
Civil or Military within the Kingdoms of  
Great Britain or Ireland Dominion of  
Town of Berwick upon Tweed &c.
