And thereupon asked the Opinion of the Board whether  
it is not very fitting his most Sacred Majesty King George  
should be proclaimed without expecting further Direc-  
tions.

It was which it was put to the Vote whether King  
should not be proclaimed to Morrow notwithstanding  
his Excellency has not any judicial Notice of the  
Majesty's Demise —

And Resolved nemine contradicente that the most  
High & Mighty Prince George Elector of Brunswick  
Lunenburg be to Morrow by twelve of the Clock  
proclaimed in this City King of Great Britain France  
& Ireland Defend. of the Faith &c —

And further advised that his Excellency will issue  
his Proclamation to the severall Counties Command-  
ing the respective Sheriffs forthwith to proclaim  
this Majesty with all the Solemnity possible  
And the following Proclamation being read & approved  
was ordered to issue Viz
