Whereas his most Excellent Majesty King Charles the Second  
 hath at the Court at London by Letters under the Great Seal  
 bearing date the first of October last 1691. Com-  
 manded that in the prayers for the Royal Family  
 in Churches of this Kingdom of Great Britain should  
 be inserted to be made in the prayers for the Royal  
 Family was put the Grace and prayer to be read  
 instead of the Royal Highness the Prince in the prayers  
 and suffrages for the Royal Family there be inserted his  
 Royal Highness George Prince of Wales & if necessary  
 directions be given accordingly. And that the said  
 spiritual persons should certify the same to the  
 within the Province to take due notice thereof & conform  
 themselves thereto. And whereas the said Letters  
 directed to the Bishop of Exeter the Bishop of Bath & the  
 first year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George by space of  
 great Britain and the Islands thereof. And that the said  
 was approved & ordered to be printed.

His Excellency is pleased to refer to the Con-  
 sideration of the Board whether it may be fit to  
 continue the Embargo laid on Indian Com-  
 modities that was seeing the said Letters his Excellency  
 mild and favourable it be reasonable to take it  
 off & suffer the Exportation thereof. And advised  
 that the Embargo be taken off. And that his Excellency  
 issue his proclamation accordingly the same.
