

Command and furnish themselves with such papers
have well advised of this Majesty's Council thought
fit to issue this my Proclamation Commanding
Enjoining all persons whatsoever having in their
possession any such papers to deliver
if they forthwith send or bring them to me to be return-
ed to the Officers Admirally in order to their being
cancelled and that such other persons as shall despoil
any voyage from this Province in any way of the
High Seas provide themselves with such papers as
may be had upon their application to and certifi-
cate of any of the Collectors of his Majesty's Customs in
this Province a considerable number of such papers
being sent from my Admiralty Officers to be
me to the end and purpose. Given at my
of Amopolis this thirteenth day of April in
the first year of the Reigne of our said Lord King
the second of June 1715. God save the King

Also the following Proclamation for preven-
ting any Illegal Trade being carried on
the said Majesty's Province and any of the French Colonies
in America being prepared was read & approved of
as follows. Vizt.
