so that the whole of the Treaty may be observed to the best
intended sense of Parliament before executed by
Order. That nothing be punctually observed & but the
Executive Council shall neglect no legal Trade to be carried on
between this Province and Maryland or
present themselves in America by any other than
Ships of War attending this Province or any other
British Settlements or Ships of either
of none of inland Subjects may be allowed to
Trade from their Settlements to this Province or
of such bad Masse good Seamen may be notiffed to
all this Subjects here I do command you the Sheriff of
the County to Publish this my Proclamation
in the most usual & frequented place
of the City of New Castle this 13th day of February
in the first Year of our Reign of our Lord & King
George the Third A.D. 1775
