 no illegal Trade be carry'd on  
 between this his Mat<sup>y</sup> Province of Maryland &  
 her Colonies in America by any of his Mat<sup>y</sup>  
 Ships of War attending this Province or any other  
 British Colonies or Ships or Vessels wherby  
 y<sup>e</sup> names of the said Subjects may be allowed to  
 Trade from their s<sup>d</sup> Settlements to this Province  
 if such his Mat<sup>y</sup> good pleasure may be notified to  
 all his Subjects here y<sup>e</sup> Command y<sup>e</sup> Sec<sup>y</sup>. The Ritts  
 the respective Countys to publish this my s<sup>d</sup> Com-  
 mand in y<sup>e</sup> most usual & frequented places -  
 especially City of Annapolis this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April  
 in the first year of y<sup>e</sup> Reign of our s<sup>d</sup> Lord King  
 Charles the first the 17<sup>th</sup> 1675

It being Considered y<sup>t</sup> it is very necessary y<sup>t</sup> when  
 any reference is made in the County of  
 Masters or Assistants in that County a reasonable  
 Fee should be payd them for their Reports

Resolved y<sup>t</sup> the s<sup>d</sup> Fee be and is hereby settled  
 & allowed to be taken if in Tobacco One hundred  
 & fifty pounds & if in Curr<sup>y</sup> money twelve shillings  
 & six pence
