Resolved of this Board that the Captain of the Ordnance  
 and his Company provide the Council that  
 wherever there is a provision made by Act  
 of Assembly for raising a Quantity of <sup>two</sup> 1000  
 not exceeding fifty thousand pounds, or  
 any necessity during the Intervall of Assembly  
 Whether in Case the Council have any Account  
 from the Governor concerning the further  
 Distress of his Majesty's Subjects at South Carolina  
 They do not agree that in regard it is very  
 difficult on any sudden Occasion to get a  
 full Council together (the Holland the Young  
 the Addison or any three of the Council  
 with the King may order the buying any  
 Quantity of 1000 not exceeding 5000 to  
 be disposed of by their Discretion - which was  
 agreed to by all the Members of the Council  
 now present

also Resolved and advised that in Case the King  
 and any three of the Council shall think  
 fit to send any Arms or Munition to South  
 Carolina for the succour of the Majesty's  
 there: It be wholly left to his Majesty's Discretion  
 with the Advice of such a Number of Council  
 And it being considered that there is not  
 sufficient a Store of Powder in the Subjects  
 Magazine
